- Combined buyers group: whether or not to approach Kiwibank





Q1: Is E-waste recycling an activity currently undertaken by your organisation?





Q2: If yes, does this currently include dismantling E-waste?





Q3: Is E-waste refurbishment an activity currently undertaken by your organisation?


