Ecopods are the NZ distributors for ecodepo. Made from recycled plastic, the pods can be free standing or wall mounted. They use jumbo-sized biodegradable bags that are colour-coded and reusable. The stands are made from powder-coated steel. Recycling labels are available on request.



The biodegradable bags that are supplied take a long time to be composted (up to 4 to 5 years). They are 50 microns thick to ensure they are strong enough to hold up to 15kgs. They can be reused and they do break down in landfill.

Friendlypak provide biodegradable and compostable bags and films made from GMO free certified corn. They also provide the MaxAir Bin for collection of kitchen waste. The bin is lined with their BioFilm Kitchen Waste Bag and the bin is ventilated to allow the waste to 'breathe' which reduces the weight of the scraps. The whole bag can be put into your compost when full and the bag will be 99% composted within 90 days.
